

WITNESS FOR HAU ARRESTED.

**Police Think Baron Lindenau Tried to
Blackmail Olga Molitor.**

BERLIN, Aug. 8.—Baron Karl Lindenau, the new witness in the Hau case, who says he saw the fatal shot fired, and that the murderer was not Karl Hau, now under sentence of death for the crime, was arrested at Mannheim last night on a charge of blackmail.

The police of Karlsruhe have given out a statement to the effect that Lindenau sent to Fraulein Olga Molitor, daughter of the late Frau Molitor, in the course of the trial of Hau for the murder of Frau Molitor, an anonymous letter declaring that he saw Olga shoot her mother, but promising to preserve silence, declaring his love, and asking Olga's hand in marriage.

The police see in this an attempt at blackmail, but the newspapers do not take Lindenau's story seriously.
