SEES GERMAN DECADENCE.

Hau Hero-Worship, Following Murder Trial, Denounced by Dr. Von Pannwitz

BERLIN, Sept. 7.—Dr. von Pannwitz, a Munich lawyer, in taking up the cudgels for Olga Molitor in connection with the Karl Hau murder case, says the epidemic of Hau hero-worship and the baiting of Olga Molitor are unwelcome signs of a growing deformity in the national character in Germany, which entirely throws into the shade anything manifested by America on similar occasions. It is a pathological symptom, he says, of which Germany need not be proud.

Dr. von Pannwitz finds further arguments in support of this alleged decadent tendency in the immense amount of cheap detective and similar literature which is being absorbed by Germany at the present time.
