HAU MAY ESCÁPE DEATH.

His Sentence Likely to be Commuted to Life Imprisonment.

LONDON, Oct. 31.—Berlin dispatches state that the death sentence pronounced upon Karl Hau of Washington, D., C., for the murder of his mother-in-law will be commuted to penal servitude for life within a few days, the Grand Duke of Baden, who has just succeeded to the throne, being unwilling to begin his reign with so sinister an event as the signing of a death warrant.
